Subject: Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule (5) of rule 14 of Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 22-05-2013, and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant of provisional recognition to the GD Goenka Public School, 3-A, Institutional Area, Model Town, Delhi - 110009 for Class Ist to Class VIIIth for a period of one year w.e.f. 01-04-2013 to 31-03-2014.

The above provisional recognition is subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

01. The grant of provisional recognition does not in any way imply any obligation for recognition beyond class VIII.
02. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
03. The School shall admit in class I (or in entry class, as the case may be), to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
04. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall maintain a separate bank account.
05. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
06. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age of proof shall adhere to the provisions of section 15 of the Act. The school shall ensure:
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.

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(iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down in under rule 22 of Delhi Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011.

(v) The students with disabilities/special are given inclusive education as per provision of the Act.

(vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.

(vii) The teachers performs their duties as specified under section 24(1) of the Right to Free and compulsory Education Act 2009 and the teachers shall not engage himself / herself for private coaching.

07. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority/ NCERT as the case may be.

08. The School shall follow the three language formula for teaching.

09. A certificate from competent authority that the school building has been constructed as per latest National Building Code has to be submitted within three months.

10. That the Management of the school shall create a reserve fund in the form of Fixed Deposit in the joint account in the name of Manager of the school and Dy. Director of Education (District concerned) equivalent to 3 months salary of staff or Rupees One Lac+Rs. 80/- per student within 3 months from the date of issue of letter.

11. That the School shall ensure that the Fire Safety equipments and arrangements are maintained as per the latest guidelines/circulars issued by Directorate of Education.

12. That the School shall comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding the arrangement made for transporting school students.

13. Salary to the staff shall be paid through crossed Cheque/Electronic clearance system.

14. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Right to Free and Compulsory Act 2009 and the instructions/orders issued from time to time. The facilities reported in at the time of last inspection are as under:-

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15. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of the school.
16. The school building or other structure or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development of children.
17. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
18. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
19. The school accounts are audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper account statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each of the statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
20. The provisional recognition Code Number allotted to the school is (will be issued). This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the appropriate authority.
21. The School furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the appropriate authority/ Government from time to time and complies with such instructions of the Appropriate Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
22. Renewal of Registration of Society if any be ensured.
23. Other conditions:
 - (a) Except for seeking Essentiality certificate from the concerned authority the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1973.
 - (b) If the school is located in unauthorised /non-conforming area, it shall submit within six months of the date of application the following documents:
 - (i) Certificate from concerned authority of DDA that it has applied for consideration with reference to zonal development plan and DDA is considering its application
 - (ii) Certificate from SDM/ADM/Forest department that the applicant school is not occupying Government land, Gram Sabha land and or protected Ridge land
 - (c) The school shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof and shall adhere to the provisions of section 15 of the RTE Act, 2009.
 - (d) The school shall abide by the directions issued by the Government from time to time.

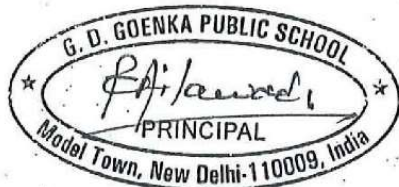

Sub:- Grant of regular recognitions of G.D. Goenka Public School, Plot no. 3A, Institutional Area, Model Town, Delhi-110009 from Pre-Primary to Sr. Secondary level (Arts, Commerce & Science Streams) without grant in aid w.e.f. 01.04.2018.

With reference to your application No.GDGPS/EDU/2017-18/040 dated 28.06.2017 on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of Director of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi for grant of regular recognitions of G.D. Goenka Public School, Plot no. 3A, Institutional Area, Model Town, Delhi-110009 from Pre-Primary to Sr. Secondary level (Arts, Commerce & Science Streams) without grant in aid w.e.f. 01.04.2018 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms & condition:-

1. That the school shall strictly abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and RTE, 2009 rules made there under as well as the instructions issued by the Director of Education from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit the students without any discrimination of religion race, caste or place of birth as per the norms of the Department.
3. The proper library shall be established and facilities for the Reading Room shall also be made available to the students as well as the teachers. Books in the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
4. The adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
5. That the employees of the school will be given salary and allowances and other facilities to staff and teachers will be made as per section 10(1) of the DSEAR, 1973 relevant section of RTE Act 2009.
6. That the school shall not run any unrecognized classes or conduct any other activities within the school premises as per Rules 50 of DSEAR, 1973 and Rule 125 of DSEAR, 1973.
7. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately and the required staff strength must be complete in all respect as per norms.
8. That the school shall submit the Returns to the Directorate of Education as per Rule 180(1) of DSEAR, 1973 annually.
9. The managing committee shall regulate the functioning of school strictly in accordance with the provisions of DSEAR 1973 and RTE Act, 2009.
10. The school shall not increase the rate of tuition fee without the prior sanction of the Directorate of Education, Delhi Admin. and shall follow the provisions of DSEAR, 1973 and other instructions issued from time to time.
11. That all the facilities prescribed under Section 4 of DSEAR 1973 read with rule 50 & 51 of DSEAR 1973 shall be made available to the students.
12. That proof of the effect that qualified staff has been appointed as per Recruitment Rules to be provided for verification by Deputy Director of Education.

13. That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made for all the students as well as the staff and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students and the staff adequately.
14. That the school shall have the medium of instruction as per Rules 6, 7 & 8 of DSEAR, 1973.
15. That the Provident Fund Register shall be maintained and the cash book completed and shown to the Deputy Director of Education of the Zone concerned for verification from time to time.
16. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund as per DSEAR, 1973.
17. That the violation any instruction/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to action against the school as per Section 21 of DSEAR, 1973.
18. That report about the fulfilment of above conditions shall be sent to the Deputy Director of Education within six months.
19. That the school shall equip the science laboratory as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
20. That all the conditions of the recognition under section 4 of the Act will continue to be complied with.
21. That the school shall provide fee and compulsory education to the children as per notification no. 15(172)/DE/Act/2010/69 dated 07.01.2011.
22. The school shall comply with the provisions of Rule 176, 177, 18(5), 17(3) & order dated 15.12.1999, 10.05.2005, 11.02.2009, 16.04.2010 & 19.02.2016 and all subsequent orders and direction dealing with the regulation of fee issued by DoE from time to time.
23. Other conditions as mentioned in recognition letter usually.
