


GRADE III

GRADE IV-V

Date: 03.05.2021

"Together we can face challenges as deep as the ocean and as high as the sky"

In the previous session, students were made familiarised with the safety precautions to be followed as to prevent the spread of COVID-19 through interesting videos. To recapitulate the same, students were asked to design beautiful posters with catchy slogans to spread awareness. It was also suggested to paste these posters in their houses at different areas as to motivate other family members to follow the DO's and DONT's.



Topic- 'VEGETATIVE PROPAGATION'

Date: 06.05.2021

In today's session, students were made familiarised with the different ways of growing plants other than using seeds. They were introduced with a new term 'vegetative propagation' which is a method of obtaining new plants from stems, roots and leaves. Firstly with the help of a module, different methods of vegetative propagation were shared with the students like cutting, layering and grafting.

ACTIVITY: Growing a new plant from a potato

The following steps were shared:

1. Take a potato with buds and wash it.
2. With the help of an elder, cut the potato into two halves.
3. Insert toothpicks from three sides of the half-cut potato.



4. Pour water in a glass and place the potato over it, making sure that the cut part is only immersed in water.



5. Keep the glass carefully in the sunlight.



6. The water can be changed after 2-3 days.

Result:

After few days, small plants can be seen growing from the potato eyes.

Students pledged that they will take care of this plant. And later when the small buds appear on potato eyes, they will transfer this into a potted plant.

Date: 18TH May 2021

In today's session, students were made sensitized about following the 4Rs strategy i.e. REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE AND REPLACE. Later, using a module they were instructed step wise to transform the old and unused t-shirt into a new tote bag. Students took help of their parents in cutting and they were really excited to try something new.



Date: 20th May 2021

“DIY ACTIVITY : DIYA MAKING”

In today's session, students were made sensitized to use eco-friendly products. There are many useful products they can make at home using simple materials available. So, in last class they made a tote bag from a T-shirt. Today another DIY activity was planned for students in which they made DIYAS using wheat flour following some simple steps:

1. Mix water and any food colour.
2. Take a big bowl and make a mixture of coloured water and wheat flour.
3. Then, make small balls of this dough.



4. Shape them into diyas



5. Use cotton wick and oil to lit them up.
